Job Readiness Program

About

The Job Readiness Program is an 8-week program designed to help participants become job-ready to work in the construction industry. Participants will learn relevant theory and skills which will set the foundation for a future apprenticeship and a successful career as a Drywall, Acoustic & Lathing Applicator.

The first four weeks of the program are in-class. Participants will earn their Ministry safety certifications, and will learn to safely use tools while learning basic Drywall skills. The in-school portion is followed by four weeks on a job placement, where participants learn as they work on a construction site.

Participants will be provided the necessary PPE and hand tools to promote their success in the program and in their future careers. The program is designed to eliminate barriers to optimize the success of all participants in the program.

Support for the Participants

- \$900 of PPE and hand tools for participants to keep at the end of the program.
- \$410/week for the four-week in-class portion of the program
- \$310/week subsidies for the four-week on-the-job portion of the program.
- Four weeks of instruction to help participants become Job Ready.
- Four weeks of job placement, secured by the local.
- Free tuition for the program
